## East Windsor Cogeneration Centre

- In February 2017, Capital Power acquired the 84-megawatt (MW) East Windsor Cogeneration Centre (East Windsor) from Veresen Inc.
- The facility is fully contracted with the Ontario Independent Electricity System Operator until 2029 and has a long-term steam agreement for Ford Motor Company's Windsor operations.
- East Windsor began commercial operation in 2009.
- The project encompasses approximately 1.5 acres of industrial land, located adjacent to the existing Ford powerhouse, and is equipped with modern emission controls that meet all federal and provincial air quality standards.

## Contributing to the local economy

- Capital Power employs three permanent employees at the facility and 16 contractors.
- We give to local communities through corporate investment programs and the efforts of our exceptional people. We've built giving into the core of our business. We support our employees and the communities in which they live and work. Each year, we match donations through our employee-matching and volunteer programs and support local organizations.
