

Dress For Your Day

What we wear to work each day reflects our individual brands, how we represent Capital Power in the community and demonstrate our commitment to our careers. Our flexible dress standard encourages you to dress for your day - offering flexibility for you to determine which standard of dress will best help you succeed at work. Whether that is business attire, business casual or casual (this includes jeans!), the choice is yours.

You're expected to use your best judgement in deciding what to wear. The guidelines below will help you define what is appropriate. When in doubt, ask first, or don't wear it.

Guidelines

- Your clothing should contribute to a positive professional image of both yourself and Capital Power.
- Consider your schedule: some days' activities require more formal attire than other days. For example, a business meeting with external parties or an outside speaking opportunity may require a suit and tie, whereas casual is fine when you're working in the office with only internal meetings.
- No matter how fashionable, avoid hats, clothing with large logos or phrases, athletic wear and clothes that are revealing, torn or excessively worn.

Your work attire in the office should always reflect who you are and the professional work you do at Capital Power.
