### Capital Power is seeking stakeholder input into its proposed Whitla Wind Phase 3 project (Whitla Wind 3).

### **Proposal Summary**

*Capital Power is proposing to build Whitla Wind 3, a nominal nameplate capacity 54-megawatt wind power facility located within the County of Forty Mile, Alberta. The proposed project will consist of 15 Vestas V-136 3.6 MW wind turbines, the same technology in operation for Whitla Wind 1 and to be installed for Whitla Wind 2.*

### **Regulatory Process and Schedule**

*Capital Power intends to submit a facility application to the Alberta Utilities Commission ("AUC") in summer 2020 for approval to construct and operate the proposed wind power facility and associated substation expansion. Based on the current project schedule, construction could begin in Summer 2021 with COD in December 2021.*
