



## **COVID-19 Site Access Protocol for Contractors and Visitors – June 24, 2022**

This document is an update to the *COVID-19 Site Access Protocol for Contractors* issued March 24, 2021 and amended August 1, 2021, and December 6, 2021.

Irrespective of the protocols described in this document, contract workers and visitors are responsible for understanding and adhering to all local health authority COVID-19 requirements applicable to the Capital Power site to which they will access.

All workers are required to adhere to the following protocols, regardless of vaccination status:

1. Upon arrival to the site for the first time, on site or following an absence of 14 or more consecutive days, workers must complete a COVID-19 Fit-for-Duty Questionnaire to gain access to the site. If access is not granted, a Capital Power representative will inform workers of the protocol to be followed to gain access.
2. Stay at home when you are sick or have any COVID-19 symptoms including, but not limited to, fever, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, sore throat, runny nose, or loss of smell or taste.
3. Alert your supervisor and a Capital Power Representative if COVID-19 symptoms develop while on a Capital Power site.
4. Follow the Contractor Return to Work Protocols as directed by Capital Power.
