I'm Christoper Ray, Site Manager for New Frontier Wind and I'm happy to be reaching out to the community. New Frontier Wind, located on approximately 10,700 acres of privately-owned lands in McHenry County, is a 99-megawatt facility with 29 Vestas turbines. Five to eight Vestas technicians work here maintaining the V-126 units.

I was lucky enough to join the Capital Power team in 2023. Prior to this, I served in the U.S. Air Force for four years as a Security Forces Leader in Germany and Iraq, and served for 13 years with the Ward County Detention Center in Minot. I thoroughly enjoyed my time in Law Enforcement and the relationships that I built with the brave men and woman that serve the community. I made the transition from Law Enforcement in early 2023 to renewable energy at New Frontier, first as a Vestas Site Manager overseeing the technicians and most recently as Capital Power's Site Manager for the facility.

At New Frontier, I've learned an immense amount of information about the technicians and the wind turbine functions. Although I am new to renewable energy, I have a better understanding of the role that we play in the future of energy while also positively impacting the local community with ongoing support. Developing and maintaining strong relationships with Vestas and the local community has always been a priority for Capital Power, and I look forward to continuing that in my Site Manager role.

We have an established community investment program, which I am proud to say has been at work in the local area. Site updates

Whooping Cranes

Capital Power continues to participate in a Whooping Crane monitoring program which employs three local community members. Each year during the Spring and Fall, observations for Whooping Cranes are monitored twice each day for any presence. If Whooping Cranes are seen in the area, our turbines are paused to provide a safe flying environment. Our results are then reported to the North Dakota Game and Fish Department, and to the US Fish and Wildlife Service who use the data to better monitor the endangered species.
