

Maple Leaf Solar Project

Hello,

We hope your 2026 is off to a great start! Construction of Capital Power's 73-megawatt (MW) Maple Leaf Solar Project ("the Project") located in Selma, Johnston County, NC began in May 2025. There are currently approximately 45 workers on site, which is expected to increase to about 150 at peak later this summer.

The project's Engineering, Procurement and Construction ("EPC") contractor, Vanguard Energy Partners, LLC ("Vanguard") began construction mobilization in September 2025 in preparation for construction activities this year. This included creating multiple entrances to the site to accommodate construction traffic, a temporary construction laydown area to accommodate equipment, adding temporary construction trailers and installing a silt fence. Groundwork for the 240 kilovolt (kV) substation has also been completed in preparation for construction of the substation beginning in March 2026.



In June 2025, site preparation and earthworks was completed for the substation's pad.

Construction Traffic and Equipment Deliveries

In January, major equipment deliveries began at a rate of approximately 15 truckloads per day. This includes delivery of the Medium Voltage Alternating Current (MVAC) cable, steel piles required to support the solar panel racking, the racking that holds the photovoltaic (PV) panels in place, inverters that will convert the direct current (DC) electricity generated by the PV panels into alternating current (AC) electricity for consumption, and approximately 194,000 PV panels and other equipment.

The piling is anticipated to be ongoing until the end of August.
